Yes, please Clinical staff wearing a uniform (as per Trust Uniform Policy) Anyone entering a patient's bed space or room When having clinical patient contact (including in Outpatients Dept.) Anyone entering PICU, NICU and CICU) unless entering a patient's bed space or room



'Bare below the Elbows' means:

- No suit jackets
- No long sleeves
- No wrist watches or bracelets
- No rings (other than a plain wedding band)

Also, please remember 'no ties or lanyards' when in direct contact with patients.
