### **INFLAMMATORY BOWEL DISEASE**

#### **DEFINITION**

Inflammatory bowel diseases (IBDs) are idiopathic, chronic, and inflammatory intestinal disorders

### **ALARM SYMTPOMS**

- Faltering growth
- Rectal bleeding
- Significant vomiting and chronic severe diarrhoea
- Severe abdominal pain
- Unexplained fevers
- Family history of inflammatory bowel disease

# **ACCEPTANCE CRITERIA FOR REFERRAL**

- All suspected IBD from secondary care
- Complex IBD from tertiary care
- Rheumatology patients & Immunology patients
- Early onset IBD from secondary/tertiary care

# ADVICE TO REFERRING DOCTOR BEFORE ACCEPTING PATIENT

GPs	To refer to local Paediatrician
Paediatricians:	Referral letter to demonstrate referral guidelines have been met
Paediatric Gastroenterologist (2 <sup>nd</sup> opinion)	Referral letter to demonstrate referral guidelines have been met

## **OUTCOME MEASURES**

- Improve care now outcomes (ICN)
  - o Growth, Remission, School attendance, Steroid use, Colectomy rates
