
REMEMBER: BABIES NHS NUMBER MUST BE INCLUDED ON THE CARD

Samples can be taken from an arterial/central line or capillary heel prick.

If taking a capillary sample:

- Clean the heel with plain, tepid water
- Additional warming of the foot is unnecessary and can be dangerous
- Perform the test using an automated incision device designed for use on newborns (tenderfoot).
- Skin puncture must be no deeper than 2 mm. The external and internal limits of the calcaneus are the preferred puncture site
- Puncture the heel and allow the blood to flow naturally
- Allow a spot of blood to drop on to each circle and seep through to the back of the card. Fill circles completely and do not layer or compress the blood. Do not allow the heel to make contact with the card. If the sample is insufficient or unsuitable a repeat will be requested.

Newborn admissions <5 days old:

Check that a single blood spot has been done at the local hospital at birth. If not:

• 1 blood spot sample must be taken on admission PRIOR to transfusion. The blood spot card should be marked 'Pre-transfusion'. The sample should be sent to the laboratory with the routine day 5 sample. This single spot tests for SCD.


Day 5-8: All babies

4 blood spot sample. All babies must have a sample taken by day 8. If a baby receives a transfusion before the day 5-8 sample, a sample should be taken on day 8 and a repeat sample should be taken the next time they are over 72 hours post transfusion. Document time of last transfusion and sample in comments.

Babies born <32 weeks gestation:(31+6 days)

• 2 blood spot sample for CHT needs to be taken at 28 days of age or at discharge home, whichever is sooner. Write 'CHT preterm' in the comments box.

Newborn blood spot screening card information



Zero tolerance Info: NHS number, D.O.B, date of sample: If any of this information is not on the card or is incorrect it will be rejected and a repeat will be requested. It is the responsibility of the person completing the card to find this info so screening isn't delayed.

Routine Info: This information should be easily available for each patient, if any of this information is missing the card will not be rejected, but the labs will have to contact the ward to chase up the information. This could delay screening. Please include details of transusions, this info is essential to ensure accurate screening.

Non-essential info: Mums NHS number etc. If this information is missing the card will still be screened so don't delay screening to obtain this information, but if you have it please include it.

Please check screening card expiry date.

Do Not use hospital patient stickers on the cards as they don't contain enough information.

Do use pre-printed barcoded labels if sent with baby from local (check information is correct and add any info not included such as date of sample and transfusion history).

Do Not use a request form. You don't need a request form for this test
