What you need:

A4 card
A pencil
Colouring pens or crayons
Scissors
Sticky tape
String or coloured thread

Make your own
mobile Lullaby Factory
inspired by some of your
favourite sounds!

What you do:

What sounds do you like to listen to? Can you draw them?
What sounds can you hear now?

- 1 On the A4 card, draw a large object and some smaller objects that represent your favourite sounds. Here is a large cloud that represents the sound of the wind. You can also see a bird that represents the sound of birds singing.



- 2 Colour in all your objects and carefully cut them out. You can then colour in both sides of the card if you like!

- 3 Use string to attach the smaller objects to the large object. You can fix the string to each object with sticky tape.

- 4 Put one long piece of string at the top so that you can hang your mobile.

- 5 You now have a fantastic mobile to remind you of your favourite sounds! You can hang it in your window or in your room.
