## Funding Opportunities

All research funding applications **MUST** be [registered with R&D](#) at **least 15 days before the funder deadline** to get costings and approvals in time for the funders deadline.


**[Rosetrees Interdisciplinary Award](#)**

**Funder deadline:** 01/03/22

**Funding available:** £300,000

**Duration of funding:** 36 months

**Eligibility:** An internal selection process is being coordinated by the Research Coordination Office for Life and Medical Sciences — 2-page expressions of interest must be submitted to [sims.facilitators@ucl.ac.uk](mailto:sims.facilitators@ucl.ac.uk) by 1 March 2022.



**[ASGBI Surgical Research Awards](#)**

**Funder deadline:** 01/03/2022

**Funding available:** £10,000

**Duration of funding:** 12 - 24 months

**Eligibility:** In association with Guts UK, the Awards are intended to fund surgical research projects studying under-researched aspects of the digestive system. Projects which cover any aspect of emergency general surgery delivery will be considered, however, priority will be given to projects in Emergency laparotomy, Diverticulitis, or Pancreatitis.



**[BMA Dawkins and Strutt Grant](#)**

**Funder deadline:** 04/03/2022

**Funding available:** £65,000

**Duration of funding:** 36 months

**Eligibility:** Applicants must be UK registered medical practitioners or research scientists working in the UK. Projects must be based in the UK. The Dawkins and Strutt research grant supports research in the field of eye health. The award can be used for proposed or current work on a specific project and will fund direct research costs over three years.




**[What's your Big Idea for UCL's Digital Research Infrastructure](#)**

**Funder deadline:** 11/03/2022

**Funding available:** no funding directly allocated to this call. Selected co-developed applications could be funded via the UCL's investment in Digital Research.

**Info Webinar:** 07/02/22

**Eligibility:** Opportunity to co-create future services or platforms which could become part of UCL's digital research infrastructure. Applicants must be available to co-create proposals with ARC staff. The digital infrastructure proposed must have the potential to have a wide impact and use beyond a single project.




**[Action Medical Research Project Grant](#)**

**Funder deadline:** 22/03/2022

**Funding available:** £ 200,000. max for joint funding with Borne is £250,000.

**Duration of funding:** 12 - 36 months

**Eligibility:** This will be an open competition round across our full remit. As part of this round, there will also be opportunities for potential [joint awards with Borne](#). Can only apply for one grant per round.



**[Reducing global health non-communicable disease risk for young people](#)**

**Funder deadline:** 19/04/2022

**Funding available:** £ 5,000,000

**Duration of funding:** 3-5 years

**Eligibility:** You must be based at a UK research organisation eligible for UKRI funding and work in partnership with co-investigators based in low or middle income countries (LMICs) where the work will take place. Your research must take a life course approach and focus on people aged 10 to 24 in LMICs.




**[MRC Career development award](#)**

**Funder deadline:** 20/04/2022

**Funding available:** no limit on amount you can apply for

**Duration of funding:** up to 5 years

**Eligibility:** The aim of this scheme is to support talented researchers who have gained a higher research degree to lead their own research plans, establish their own research team, and make the transition to independent investigator. You must have a PhD or equivalent, show evidence of career progression and show clear plans for developing as a leader in your specialist area of research.



**[British Academy Global Professorships Programme](#)**


**Funder deadline:** 27/04/2022

**Internal selection process:** 10/02/2022

**Funding available:** £ 90,000

**Duration of funding:** 12 - 36 months

**Eligibility:** Grants are available to mid-career and senior researchers in any discipline. Candidates should be based outside the UK at the time of application. Applicants who are working outside the UK but are employed primarily by a UK institution are not eligible to apply. **[LifeArc Early Ventures Funding](#)**

**Funder deadline:** ongoing

**Funding available:** £ 5,000,000

**Duration of funding:** 12-36 months

**Eligibility:** Investment funding to support early-stage spin-out companies developing innovative medical products and technologies with the potential to impact on patients' lives. Investment is aimed at nascent and early-stage spin-out companies with strong intellectual property positions and a proposition which it deems deliverable to market.
