Needle cortisone injection (WFI)

Equipment




Open WFI and Hydrocortisone

10

Under 1yr

= 25mgs



Attach needle and syringe

Draw up

1ml water

5

Remove air

Add to **Hydrocortisone**

Mix gently



Withdraw dose



Remove air



Dose Dose 1-5 yrs = 6+ yrs = 50mgs 100mgs
