You can use this artwork to inspire your own fantastic forest. There are lots of different type of forests including coniferous forests, tropical rain forests, temperate rain forests and mangrove forests. Can you think of animals in these forests? And how do they change through the year or even the day?

What you will need for your mini forest:

Thick white card:
1 x A4 and 1 x A3

Scissors
A pencil
Colouring pencils, felt tip pens or oil pastels

Your Imagination!

Ask an adult or play worker to help you find materials.

What You Do!



Think of animals and leaves for your jungle and draw them all over the A4 sheet of card. Also fill in the other side so you have drawings on both sides.

On the A3 sheet draw tree templates- make sure you can fit 4 trees on your A4 sheet but don't make them too small! Make sure all the bottoms of your trees have a big flat base.

Cut out your templates and use a pencil to draw round them on your coloured sheet. Then cut out your trees.

Using the left over pieces, cut 4 x large rectangles for the base of your trees. Cut slots half way up the rectangles and slots the same length up the trees, then slot them together.

Using the left overs make bits of grass and foliage for the forest floor.
