Protocol for the use of Epidurals

General instructions

No supplementary opioids unless ordered by the Anaesthetist or Pain Service

Maintain IV access during opioid infusion + 12 hours after cessation

Record observations according to Clinical Practice Guidelines

Assess pain HOURLY while on Epidural, continue for 6 hours after cessation

■ Multi-modal / synergistic analgesia — ensure it is prescribed and use it

■ Treatment of Nausea & vomiting: Give antiemetics as prescribed

side-effects: **Itching:** Naloxone

Urinary retention: Naloxone as prescribed. If fails - catheterise

Over sedation: See Sedation Scale

Respiratory depression: Resp rate: If less than shown on drug chart:

Give oxygen
 Stop infusion
 Give naloxone
 Call Pain Service

4 microgram/kg IV
