

# Giving consent



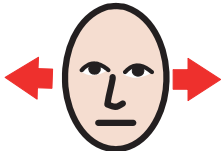
You are coming to hospital to see a doctor.

Before they do anything, they must ask if you agree.  
This is called 'giving consent'.

You can say "no"

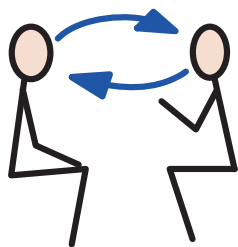


Before you decide, the doctor must tell you what they plan to do.

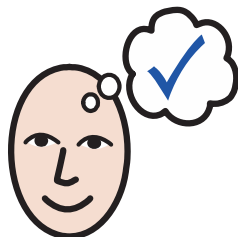


You should ask any questions.

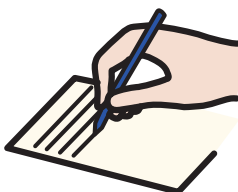
# Giving consent



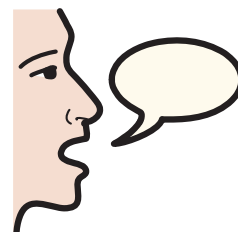
You can talk to someone about what the doctor said.

You should be sure you understand before you say yes or no.



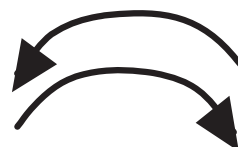
- The doctor may ask you to sign a consent form.



- They may ask you to say you agree.



- They may ask you to do something.
