Please provide me with the below information relating to staffing within the diagnostic radiography/medical imaging department (all modalities including: General X-Ray, CT, MRI, Mammography)

Great Ormond Street Hospital for Children NHS Foundation Trust (the 'Trust') is a single site, specialist tertiary paediatric trust. Please see our response to your following request for information; however, please note that bank and agency spend are for the cost centres in question; not just radiographers:

- 1. How many permanent staff are employed by the Radiography/Imaging department (Radiographers & Sonographers, not Radiologists)? **61**
- 2. How many permanent vacancies are currently open/unfilled within the Radiography/Imaging department (Radiographers & Sonographers, not Radiologists)? **0**
- 3. How many agency staff/locums are currently being used across the Radiography/Imaging department (Radiographers & Sonographers, not Radiologists)? **None**
- 4. For agency staff/locums, what is the split in numbers between radiographers and sonographers? **N/A**
- 5. How many bank temps are being used across the Radiography/Imaging department? The Trust does not have bank only temps; as radiography substantive staff can also undertake bank work
