Thank you for your request for information processed under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. Please see our response to your requests for information below:

Your Request

I'm looking into secondary care discharge letters and referrals and would like a few questions to be answered under the Freedom of Information Act.

Please could you provide answers to each separate question covering the following time periods:

The first covering the time period 1st January 2015 – 31st December 2015; The second covering the time period 1st January 2016 – 31st December 2016; The third covering the time period 1st January 2017 – 31st December 2017; and the fourth covering the time period 1st January 2018 – 31st December 2018.

1. For each time period, how many discharge summaries were sent to GP practices after 24 hours of a discharge of a patient? i.e how many discharge summaries were delayed in sending to GPs? This counts for outpatient, inpatient, day case and A&E care.

Also, if you are able to answer within the confines of the FOI limitations, please answer the following:

- 2. For each time period, how many discharge summaries included planned and
- requested actions for GPs?
- 3. How many consultant to consultant (C2C) referrals were made in each time period?

Our Request for Clarification

Great Ormond Street Hospital is a single site, specialist tertiary paediatric trust and does not have an A&E department. We believed your request for information to be focusing on general hospitals discharging patients within 24 hours and sending discharge summaries to GPs. We therefore contacted you to provide the following clarification:

NHS Foundation Trust

 Whether general hospitals discharging patients within 24 hours and sending discharge summaries to GPs is the focus of your request for information?

Great Ormond Street Hospital does not centrally record discharge summary information and would estimate your request to be too broad to process within the 18 hour cost limit under Section 12 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

Your Response to Our Request for Clarification

We are asking for data from all trusts, including tertiary trusts, thus we would like any data you hold centrally.

Our Response

Great Ormond Street Hospital for Children NHS Foundation Trust (the 'Trust') is a single site, specialist tertiary paediatric trust. The Trust does not centrally record the information you have requested, however, we have carried out a search via our information services to see whether the information can be collated within the 18 cost limit for processing a request for information. Please see our response (in bold) to your following request for information:

<u>Please note</u>: The Trust does not have an A&E department as GOSH is specialist tertiary paediatric trust. Outpatient data has not been included as GOSH is not subject to a 24 hour turnaround target. For Discharge Summaries, we are unable to differentiate between what has been sent to GP practices, families and other providers, therefore, we have provided the data covering all discharge summaries.

1. For each time period, how many discharge summaries were sent to GP practices after 24 hours of a discharge of a patient? i.e how many discharge summaries were delayed in sending to GPs? This counts for outpatient, inpatient, day case and A&E care. Please our response in the following table based on inpatient NHS activity relating to discharges where a discharge letter was required:

- 2. For each time period, how many discharge summaries included planned and requested actions for GPs? The Trust has been unable to identify any discharge summaries recorded in the format of planned and requested actions for GPs.
- 3. How many consultant to consultant (C2C) referrals were made in each time period?

<u>Please note</u>: GOSH is a tertiary and quaternary centre and, therefore, approximately 90% of all referrals will be received from other hospitals. As such, the number of Consultant to Consultant referrals will be significantly more at GOSH compared to other organisations.
