

£15 million will be available to fund up to fifteen projects. The Trustees hope that trials in immuno-oncology will form a significant proportion of the awarded grants but they encourage applicants to submit all projects that meet the criteria below:

- 1. Be a clinical trial of a medicinal product, device or clinical procedure.
- 2. Have a reasonable prospect of improving treatment.
- 3. Will provide initial outcomes of the trial within 36 months of grant activation.
- 4. Cannot be readily funded elsewhere.
