GOSH Applications

All other applications must be registered at least 15 working days before the deadline as usual.

UCL Applications

For proposals to be checked and submitted prior to the Christmas closure period the Worktribe pro-posal must be at 'Bid Approval' status with Pre-Award by 5pm Wednesday 11 December. Where proposals are required to be submitted via an online funder portal, the proposal must be on the portal with Research Support by 9am Thursday 19 December.
