Your Request

Please can I request any information that is available for the below questions:

- Does a specific venous thromboembolism protocol exist for your Trust If so:
 - What date was this protocol put into place
 - When is it due for review
- Is there a preferred Direct Oral Anticoagulant (DOAC) or are all utilised within the trust for VTE.
- How many patients have been treated for VTE with a DOAC in the last 12 months
- What volume of each DOAC was used to Treat in this same time period

Our Response

Great Ormond Street Hospital for Children NHS Foundation Trust (the 'Trust') is a single site, specialist tertiary paediatric trust. The Trust does not hold the information requested. The treatment for VTE is a specialist area and patients will normally be assessed and managed on a 'case by case' basis. We have not treated any patients with VTE in the last 12 months with a direct oral anticoagulant. These drugs are not currently licensed in children.
