Thank you for your request for information processed under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. Please see our response to your following request for information:

## Your Request and Our Response (in bold)

Please see the response to your following request for information from Great Ormond Street Hospital for Children NHS Foundation Trust (the 'Trust'):

How many patients have received an iron infusion in the last 12 months? **114** - many of our patients have received multiple infusions, such as, dialysis patients.

How many patients have been treated with Monofer and how many with Ferinject? 74 patients have been treated with Ferinject - We only use iron sucrose (Venofer) and Ferric carboxymaltose (Ferinject).

What was the average weight of these patients? **32.84kg for patients treated** with Ferinject

How many patients required more than 1 gram of iron? None

How many nurses and for what days and hours are your Iron infusion clinics available? We do not have an infusion clinic; but patients have their infusions within our day care units; and there are no specific days or /times for iron infusion treatments.
