Who we are:

The Family Liaison Nurses are all experienced neonatal or paediatric intensive care nurses. Esther, Petra and Katie previously worked on the units as Sisters. A senior nurse from NICU/PICU joins the team for a one-year rotation before returning to their former role.

What we do:

We aim to meet and orientate all families of children admitted to NICU and PICU to provide comprehensive advice and support.

We work closely with the psychosocial team of psychologist, social workers, chaplains, play specialist, community midwives and any others involved with children and families.

We provide a point of contact for families either before a planned admission or during an inpatient stay.
