## Funding Opportunities

All research funding applications **MUST** be [registered with R&D](#) at least **15 days before the funder deadline** to get costings and approvals in time for the funders deadline.

### [Little Princess Trust Project Grants](#)

**Funder deadline:** 23/02/2022

**Funding available:** £ 200,000

**Duration of funding:** 36 month max

**Eligibility:** Researchers must have a contract which encompasses the duration of the proposed grant. Please read the terms and conditions and the guidance for applicants before starting an application.



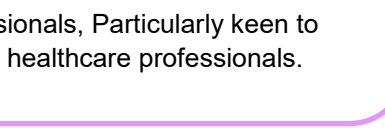
### [Child Development Grants](#)

**Funder deadline:** 13/02/2022

**Funding available:** £ 60,000

**Duration of funding:** 12 - 36 months

**Eligibility:** Currently inviting applications for research funding into three different topics: Sleep, ADHD, or Exercise. Particularly interested in research related to neurodevelopmental disorders and their co-occurrence.



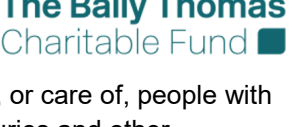
### [Glaucoma UK/UKEGS Research Award](#)

**Funder deadline:** 28/02/2022

**Funding available:** £ 50,000

**Duration of funding:** 12 - 36 months

**Eligibility:** Open to medical and non-medical professionals, Particularly keen to hear from optometrists, orthoptists, nurses and allied healthcare professionals.

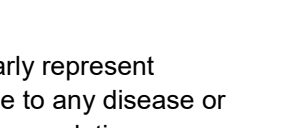


### [Baily Thomas Charitable Fund Doctoral Fellowship](#)

**Funder deadline:** 01/03/2022

**Funding available:** £ 81,000

**Eligibility:** The Fund does not give grants for research into, or care of, people with mental illness, dyslexia, dyspraxia, autism, ADHD, head injuries and other neurological impairments if they do not also have learning disabilities/ intellectual disabilities



### [Rosetrees 2022 Interdisciplinary Award](#)

**Funder deadline:** 28/04/2022

**Funding available:** £300,000

**Duration of funding:** 36 months

**Eligibility:** Applications should be interdisciplinary and clearly represent collaboration between medicine and AI/ML. They can relate to any disease or medical condition that affects a significant proportion of the population.



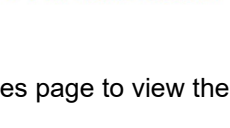
### [Teenagers and Young Adults With Cancer Late Effects Research Grant](#)

**Funder deadline:** 02/03/2022

**Funding available:** £ 30,000

**Duration of funding:** 24 months

**Eligibility:** Project grants to support research on late effects of cancer treatment for teenagers and young adults, focusing on priorities identified by the James Lind Alliance TYA Cancer Priority Setting Partnership.



### [British Heart Foundation New Horizons Grants](#)

**Funder deadline:** ongoing

**Funding available:** £300,000

**Duration of funding:** 12 - 36 months

**Eligibility:** The principal investigator will be a senior researcher working in an established research institution in the UK. The PI/ Co-PI should include researcher(s) from outside traditional cardiovascular biology, who do not have extensive existing collaborations with cardiovascular researchers.

**Funding available:** Various

**Duration of funding:** 12 - 36 months
