If your child Bone anchored hearing aid stops working, follow the instructions below:

No sound


- Change the battery. We also recommend trying a battery from another pack if it was changed recently.
- Check if the battery door is loose or doesn't shut firmly. You should hear a click when you close the battery door.

Intermittent or no reduced sound

- Change the battery. We also recommend trying a battery from another pack it was changed recently.
- Check if the battery door is loose or doesn't shut firmly. You should hear a click when you close the battery door.
- Check for some dirt in the connector or on the microphones. We recommend using a small brush or a dry cloth to clean it.
- Check for some moisture in the battery door. If any, open the battery door and let it dry or change the battery door.

Whistling/Feedback

- o Bone anchored hearing aid worn on a soft band are more inclined to whistle
- Check if the softband is tight enough on your child head. You should only be able to place two fingers under the softband.
- If the device is worn on an abutment or magnet, check that is well connected.
- Check that the device is not touching any surface (e.g. ear, hair, babysit or hat). We recommend re-placing the device till the feedback reduces. If your baby is in a push chair, you can place the device more towards the forehead.
